## ONE RACE. MANY PLACES. ONE PLACE

Year 5 have now completed their amazing art project. Working with the theme of “Our World Citizenship” as a starting point and looking closely at: “World Geography and Cultural Colours” for inspiration, our aim was to produce a huge scale painted/wire- framed/ woven wall installation, celebrating our world and its global community to which we all belong, which will be on permanent display in the main Hall.

Working on a world map base painted by the children onto MDF sheets; using wire netting, yarn, beads and cord and pre-constructed wire weaving ‘stars’, all children from Y5 worked in 5 Groups under the guidance of 5 Group Leaders (1 for each group) and one overall Year group “Project Leader”, to produce their own themed sections of a rigid grid, representing the First Peoples Cultural Colour palettes of each country in the world, working from their own research and design development at all times. In addition to the main workshop, they also created a series of interchangeable ‘Pupil Profiles’, spotlighting those children belonging to our Featherstone Family whose roots herald from the many countries represented on our installation. These regularly changed profiles have been mounted in clear acrylic frames installed on the wire grid and linked to the appropriate country with lengths of decorated cord. Whilst the work was ongoing, they also created a “Project Journal”, to showcase all the children’s research and capture their own reflections and interpretations of the Project.

A huge well done to all the Year 5’s. You have produced an amazing one off piece of work.

## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION: Car Free School Streets – Featherstone Primary School**

Many schools experience traffic related issues at the start and end of the school day. Birmingham City Council is introducing Car Free School Streets to address these issues by restricting traffic in the streets surrounding some schools at drop off and pick up times.

As part of our work to encourage healthier, greener and safer travel to school, we are pleased that Featherstone Primary School will be taking part in a pilot of this scheme from 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2019. This will reduce congestion and improve air quality at the school gates as well as making it easier and safer to walk or cycle to school.

**From 2nd September 2019 the following restrictions will be in place:**

<b>WHERE:</b> Glenville Drive and Haywards Close, Erdington, Birmingham, B23.	
<b>Times:</b>	
Mornings	Monday to Friday: Closure from: 08:15 to: 9.15
Afternoons	Monday to Thursday: Closure from: 2.30 to: 3.30 Friday closure from: 1.15 to: 2.15

**During these times, most vehicles will not be able to drive into the road(s) covered by this restriction.** Signage will be in place at the entrance(s) to the restricted zone.

There will be some exemptions that will permit traffic to use these roads at these times, including residents, blue badge holders and emergency services.

Anyone driving in the restricted zone at these times without a valid permit or exemption can be issued with a **Fixed Penalty Notice charge of £50.**

‘For those parents/carers travelling from further away we would ask that you park a short distance away from the school in the adjacent side roads (e.g. Low Wood Road, Chudleigh Road, Milverton Road, Beach Dene Grove) and walk the last part of your journey.’

This change will be made using an Experimental Traffic Regulation Order (ETRO) which can stay in place for a maximum of 18 months. During this time, we will monitor and assess the effect of this change before deciding whether it should be made permanent. As part of this, we will be inviting feedback on the scheme from parents/carers and local residents.

**To enable you to find out more about what is happening, we are organising a drop-in session on 9<sup>th</sup> July 2019 from 4pm to 5.45pm. This will provide an opportunity to find out more information and ask any questions that you have.**
