

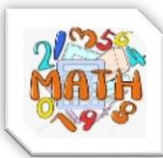


What have EYFS been up to this week?

In Phonics this week, we have been revisiting all the sounds we have learnt so far. We are practising to read all longer words. We have been focusing hard on writing words using our phonics knowledge. Some of us have been reading wordless books. Most of us are reading books with short words and some of us with short sentences!



In Maths, we focused on doubles to 10. We did this by identifying how many circles there were by counting the circles. We drew the same number of circles. Then we counted the total of circles we had to find the double. We learnt vocabulary such as double.



In Literacy, we learnt to write simple sentences about real-life superheroes. We did this by looking at the pictures and writing sentences. We sounded out the words and remembered our capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.



In Topic...

This week, we made superhero capes and masks. We did this by decorating our own emblem. This was stuck onto a bin liner with velcro dots to join the handles together to make a cape. We decorated a mask and our teachers tied elastic string so that we could wear them. We finished our Topic of superheroes off with having a fashion show. All the children looked super cool!



In Jigsaw we learnt how to help ourselves go to sleep and understand why sleep is good for us.
