



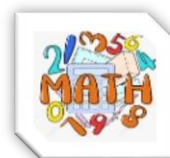
What have EYFS been up to this week?



In Phonics this week, we have been revisiting all the sounds we have learnt so far. We are practising to read all longer words. We have been focusing hard on writing words using our phonics knowledge. Some of us have been reading wordless books and some of us are reading books with short sentences.



In Maths, we focused on height and length. We did this by identifying long objects and short objects in the classroom and compared which one was shorter/longer. We did the same for height and compared objects. We learnt vocabulary such as long/er, short/er and tall/er.



In Literacy, we read the story 'How to be a Superhero'. As a class we learnt how to describe some superheroes. In our books we labelled our superhero with the words mask, boots, belt, cape and gloves. We used our phonics to sound out the words and write them down.



### In Topic...

This week, we learnt all about pretend and real-life superheroes. We learnt some superhero facts. We learnt about real-life superheroes who help us like policemen/women, nurses, doctors etc. In our books we sorted the pretend superheroes from the real life superheroes. Some of us drew our own superheroes and some of us coloured superheroes in.



In Jigsaw we learnt all about exercise and how to keep healthy.
