



What have EYFS been up to this week?

In Phonics this week, we have been revisiting all the sounds we have learnt so far. We are practising to read all longer words. We have been focusing hard on writing words using our phonics knowledge. Some of us have been reading wordless books and some of us are reading books with short sentences.



In Maths, we focused on sorting 9 and 10. We identified the number bonds to 9 and 10. In our books we had to sort the cards by 9 and 10. We learnt vocabulary such as sort, number bonds and number.



In Literacy, we learnt to write simple sentences about our mums. We did this by talking about why our mums are special and what they do for us. We described our mums using the words funny, caring, pretty and kind. We remembered our capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.



In Topic...

This week, we learnt all about Mother's day and how it is celebrated on a Sunday every year. We made some lovely cards for our mums. We have been practising really hard for our Mother's day assembly by singing songs, reading poems and writing nice messages for our mums. We hope you enjoy the assembly on Monday!
