

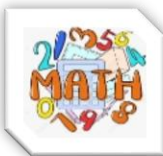


### What have EYFS been up to this week?

In Phonics this week, we have been revisiting all the sounds we have learnt so far. We are practising to read all longer words. We have been focusing hard on writing words using our phonics knowledge. We have been completing our phonics assessments to see how much we have learnt from last half term!



In Maths, we consolidated all the learning that has taken place for the last half-term. We completed assessments and did some activities based on time, length, height, subitising and much more.



In Literacy, we focused on our name writing. Most of us could write our names independently. It was great to see the progress made from Autumn.
