



What have EYFS been up to this week?



The sounds we have learnt this week are g, o, c, k. We looked at the graphemes and learnt the phonemes for each sound. We reviewed all the sounds we have learnt so far. We practised writing the graphemes on whiteboard.



In Maths we focused on size. First, we identified which objects were big/small. Then, we guessed which objects could fit in the box depending on the size for example, a giraffe could fit in a tall box. We learnt vocabulary such as big, small, tall and short.



In Literacy we are continuing to practise our name writing. Some of us were able to write our names by looking at our name card. Most of us were able to write with support and some of us practised writing the first letter of our name. We have also been practising writing the sounds we have learnt in Phonics.



### In Topic...

This week we finished off painting our self portraits. We painted our hair and added some googly eyes. Some children went ahead and used felt tips to make a portrait of themselves that they could take home. We spoke about how we are all a family at featherstone and our teachers hung our portraits in our classroom.
