



What have EYFS been up to this week?



The sounds we have learnt this week are i, n, m, d. We looked at the graphemes and learnt the phonemes for each sound. The children have tried really hard in remembering all the sounds so far even though it is tricky to remember them all.



In Maths we are focused on matching and matching sets. First, we identified different objects. Then, we sorted out a pile of objects to their matching pair. We learnt vocabulary such as matching, sets and same.



In Literacy we have been practising our name writing. First, we identified our names with the initial letter sound. Then we practised writing our names using whiteboard pens. We finally wrote our names in our books. Some of us had excellent letter formation and could write our names without support which was amazing! We will continue to practise name writing so that we are confident in writing our names independently.

This week we painted our self portraits. We had a look in the mirror to identify our features and the colour of our eyes and hair. We then painted a portrait of ourselves. Mr Gravell and Miss Ahmed were super impressed with all the portraits and how accurate they were!
