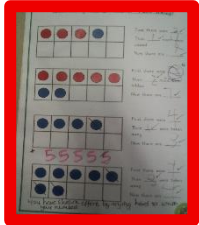


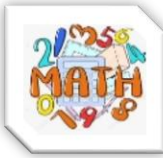


What have EYFS been up to this week?

In Phonics this week, we have been learning some new tricky words including 'were', 'little', 'here' and 'says'. We have been focusing hard on writing words using our phonics knowledge. Some of us have been reading books with short words and others are reading books with short sentences.



In Maths, we focused on 'How many did I add/ take away?'. We did this by counting the number of marbles in the jar and representing the number on the tens frame using red counters. We added a few more marbles and represented the amount added in yellow counters. We used sentence stems such as "First there were.... Then were added and now there are altogether". We did the same for subtraction.



In Literacy, we read the story 'Amelia Earhart'. In our books, we labelled the different parts of an aeroplane. We learnt that labels provide short information. We used our phonics to sound out the words, count the sounds and write them down.



In Topic...

This half term our Topic is 'Transport'. This week our focus was aeroplanes! We learnt the meaning of the word 'famous' and that Amelia Earhart was famous for being the first woman to fly an aeroplane over the Atlantic Ocean. We also learnt that she flew over the Pacific Ocean and did not return. In our books we made a missing persons poster in the hopes of finding Amelia Earhart! We described Amelia Earhart's appearance and wrote these down.



In Jigsaw we learnt about ways to solve problems and stay friends.
