

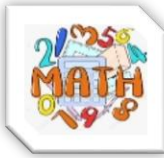


What have EYFS been up to this week?

In Phonics this week, we have been learning some new tricky words including 'come', 'love', 'do' and 'some'. We have been focusing hard on writing words using our phonics knowledge. Some of us have been reading books with short words and others are reading books with short sentences.



In Maths, we focused on numbers beyond 10. We did this by putting ten in our head and counting on using our fingers. We played a game where we chose a number beyond 10 and each child had to say a number and whoever landed on the number that was chosen was out. In our books we cut and stick the numbers in order.

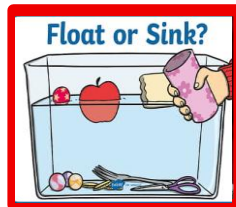


In Literacy, we read the story 'Toy Boat'. We learnt that describing means saying what something looks like. In our books we wrote some sentences on describing the boat. We remembered our capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.



In Topic...

This half term our Topic is 'Transport'. This week our focus was boats! We tested a range of items that could float and sink. Then we made some predictions on which boat will float or sink and thought about the material used to make the boat. We tested out boats made from card, paper, tissue and sugar paper.
