## EYFS Weekly Newsletter –6<sup>th</sup> March 2026

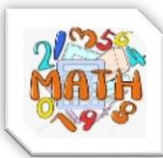


### What have EYFS been up to this week?

In Phonics this week, we have been revisiting all the sounds we have learnt so far. We are practising to read all longer words. We have been focusing hard on writing words using our phonics knowledge. Some of us have been reading wordless books and some of us are reading books with short sentences.



In Maths, we focused on sequencing time. We did this by timing how many things we could do in 30 seconds. We also learnt how to sequence our morning routine and discussed when we brush our teeth and get dressed. We learnt vocabulary such as first, next and last.



In Literacy, we learnt to write simple sentences about superheroes. We did this by looking at the picture of the superhero, making a sentence to describe the superhero and then saying the sounds out loud and writing them down. We remembered our capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.



### In Topic...

This week, we learnt about Ramadan as well as Superheroes. We learnt that people who take part in Ramadan go without food and water from sunrise to sunset. We also learnt that people give charity during this time and do kind things for others. For superheroes we read a story called 'Supertato'. In our books we designed our own capes ready for our practical activity after next week.



In Jigsaw we learnt how moving and resting are good for our bodies.



The children had lots of fun on World Book Day and looked amazing in their costumes and comfy clothes. The children to stories from 4 authors read by 4 different teachers. They took part in activities linked to the story they had listened to.
