



What have EYFS been up to this week?



In Phonics this week we have been revisiting the sounds we have learnt from the start. We are practising writing the graphemes and focusing on blending words.



In Maths we focused on recognising numbers 1-5. We practised our number formations and then matched the number blocks to the number. We learnt vocabulary such as 'number' and 'represent'.



In Literacy we are continuing to practise writing the sounds we have learnt in Phonics. We matched the initial letter sounds to the pictures. We did this by looking at the pictures and found out which picture belonged to which sound.



### In Topic...

This week we learnt about Diwali, we learnt that this is the celebration for the Festival of Lights. The children made Diya lamps out of clay and painted them. We also learnt about different types of homes such as, flat, terraced house, detached house, semi detached house, caravan and bungalow. We added furniture that we have in our homes.
