



What have EYFS been up to this week?



In Phonics this week we have been practising the ff, ll and ss sounds. We have learnt that these sounds are also digraphs. We are continuing to focus on blending words with the sound we have learnt for the day.



In Maths we focused on Subitising numbers 1-5. We practically identified how many objects there were without having to count. In our books we wrote the total amount without counting. Some of us matched the amount to a number. We learnt vocabulary such as 'subitise' and 'subitition'.



In Literacy we are practising our letter formation. This week we practiced writing 'L'. First, we practised writing the letter in the air, then we moved onto writing on whiteboard and finally in our books. We matched the initial letter sounds to the pictures. We did this by looking at the pictures and found out which picture belonged to which sound.



In Topic...

This week we learnt about light sources. We read the story 'Day monkey, Night monkey'. We wrote a list of light sources to help Day monkey see in the night. We then sorted out objects and discussed which objects give us light and which do not.



In PSHE we learnt that everyone is good at different things. We learnt vocabulary such as proud, happy and special.
