




### What have EYFS been up to this week?

In Phonics this week, we have been practising the oo as in moon, oo as in hook, and ar and or sounds. We are practising all of our tricky words from last half term. We have been focusing hard on writing words using our phonics knowledge. Most of us have been reading wordless books and some of us are reading books with short sentences.



In Maths, we focused on 'More and Less'. We learnt how to add one more/one less to an amount and noticed that our number gets bigger/smaller. We learnt the symbol for add and subtract. In our books we identified which group had more/less and then went on to finding one more/ less from the number given to us. We learnt vocabulary such as 'more' and 'less'.




In Literacy, we recapped our knowledge of house names. We shared what type of house we lived in. We had a go at describing our houses. We learnt what the word 'describe' meant. In our books we drew a picture of our home and write the sentence 'I live in a...'. We also described our homes by writing 'it is big/small'.



### In Topic...

This week, we did some investigating of different materials to build a house with. We learnt the word 'prediction' and predicted which material would be the best to build with. We then tested our materials such as pebbles, lollypop sticks, playdough, lego and Magnetic tiles. We recorded our results in our books.
