



What have EYFS been up to this week?



The sounds we have learnt this week are 'ck,e,u,r'. We looked at the graphemes and learnt the phonemes for each sound. We practised writing the graphemes on whiteboards while saying the catchphrase to help us write the grapheme. We learnt what a diagraph is for example 'ck'. A diagraph is two letters that make one sound.



In Maths we focused on matching. We matched socks by colour and pattern. We found the matching pairs and stuck them together in our Maths books. We learnt vocabulary such as the 'same' and 'matching'.

In Literacy we are continuing to practise writing the sounds we have learnt in Phonics. We matched the initial letter sounds to the pictures. We did this by looking at the pictures and saying what they were and then looking at the initial sounds and finding out which sound belonged to which picture.



### In Topic...

This week we discovered what the five senses were. We used our senses to taste fruit, touch different textures, smell mint, describe what we could see out the window and hear different noises.



On Friday we celebrated Mental Health Day. The children came in their colourful clothes and we focused on the Colour Monster story. We learnt about different feelings and made the colour monster out of playdough and collage.
