





What have EYFS been up to this week?

In Phonics this week, we have been revisiting all the sounds we have learnt so far. We are practising tricky words *we*, *me*, and *be*. Please continue to practise these with your child at home.

In Maths, we focused on composing numbers 1-5. We learnt that numbers are made up of other numbers and in parts. In our books we had to draw counters onto the fives frame in different colours to show the different parts. We learnt vocabulary such as 'compose' and 'composition'.

In Literacy, some of us wrote the word to match a picture. We did this by sounding out the word and writing each sound that we could hear. Most of us wrote the initial sound to match the picture and some of us matched the sound to the picture.



In Topic...

This week, we have been learning to respect peoples beliefs. We learnt about winter festivals and focused on Hannukah, Christmas and Diwali. We learnt that Hannukah and Diwali are both festivals of lights and learnt which foods people eat and what clothing people wear during these celebrations.
