The children in EYFS have continued to successfully settle well in school. They have completed their first week of full-time hours which has been amazing. On Monday, we started Jigsaw. All year groups have a different piece of a jigsaw teddy. The children were able to meet our year groups 'jiggy' who is called Jigsaw Jenie. This week we learnt about feelings. We identified feelings such as happy, sad, upset and excited. The children took turns to hold Jenie and speak about their feelings and elaborated on why they were feeling that way. The children showed respect by listening as their peers discussed their feelings.



On Monday we also started our Phonics programme called Little Wandle. The sounds we have learnt so far are s,a,t,p,i. We learnt some terminology such as grapheme and phoneme. The children were really interested in looking at the objects that began with the sound taught for the day.



This week the children have been completing the Reception Baseline assessments. They have all tried so hard and we are very proud of them!
