




What have EYFS been up to this week?

In Phonics this week, we have been practising the ai, ee, and igh and oa sounds. We are practising all of our tricky words from last half term. We have been focusing hard on writing words using our phonics knowledge. Most of us have been reading wordless books and some of us are reading books with short sentences.



In Maths, we focused on shapes with 4 sides such as squares and rectangles. We learnt that squares have equal sides whereas rectangles have two long sides and two short sides. We also learnt that if we tilt a square, we can make another shape called a diamond. In our books we identified and coloured in the shapes with 4 sides. We learnt vocabulary such as 'square' and 'rectangle'.



In Literacy, we read the story of 'The Three Little Pigs'. We found out that the house made of bricks was the strongest. We labelled a picture of a house. We learnt to use our phonics to spell words phonetically such as chimney, roof, door and window. Some of us identified the words and labelled them by sticking it in. It was tricky but the children tried hard!



In Topic...

This week, we learnt all about houses and homes. We learnt the names of houses and had to match the picture to the correct name. We learnt facts such as a bungalow only has one floor and that houses are made of brick and concrete.
