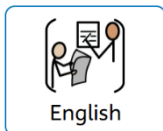

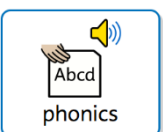


What have The Hub children been up to this week?



English

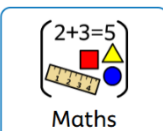
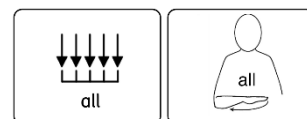
phonics

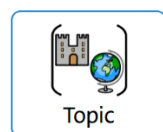
Communication

In maths this week we have been sorting animals by size into big and little. We have used the Makaton signing and widget symbols to help us sort the animals according to their size. We have also been splashing animals into a shallow tray of water. We have made big splashes and little splashes.
