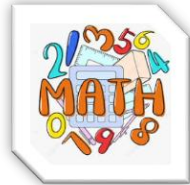


Year 2 Weekly Newsletter – 19th September

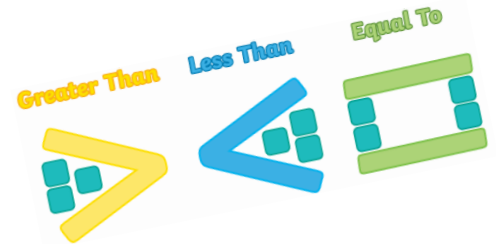
What have Year 2 been up to this week?



This week in English, we have been continuing our work on Little Red Riding Hood. First, we recapped the story and sequenced the events, before drawing a story map. This week in our Maths lessons, we have been continuing our learning on place value and understanding numbers. We have written numbers as words, looked at what each digit represents and now we are comparing numbers. We even learnt some new symbols to help us compare!
