



### What have Year 2 been up to this week?

This week in English, the children have been busy exploring the exciting world of rhyming words and patterns. They enjoyed spotting rhymes, playing with sounds, and using their creativity to write their very own poems. There were some fantastic and imaginative ideas shared. Alongside this, we celebrated World Book Day, which brought lots of excitement into the classroom. The children loved sharing stories, talking about their favourite books, and taking part in book-related activities that celebrated a love of reading. It has been a joyful and creative week full of words, rhythm, and stories.



In Maths, the children have been learning all about fractions. They have been exploring unit and non-unit fractions and developing their understanding of one half and quarters. The children have practised finding and recognising two quarters and have also been challenged to find three quarters using a range of practical activities and visual representations. This has helped them build confidence and deepen their understanding of how fractions work in everyday contexts.

### In Topic...

This week, in Geography, the children went on a trip to Sutton Park. They explored different human and physical features before partaking in some litter picking. Then the children wrote a short reflection about their trip to Sutton Park, sharing what they enjoyed and what they learned. In RE, the children talked about looking after our planet and why it is important to care for the world around us. In Science, the children explored what makes something waterproof by looking at different materials and discussing their ideas.



This week in PSHE, we learned that staying relaxed helps us feel calm, confident and ready to learn.
