

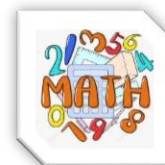


What have Year 2 been up to this week?

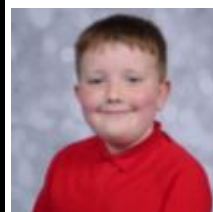


This week in PSHE, we learnt about being relaxed and how this makes our bodies feel.
