



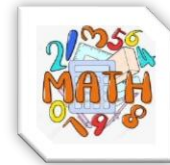
### What have Year 2 been up to this week?

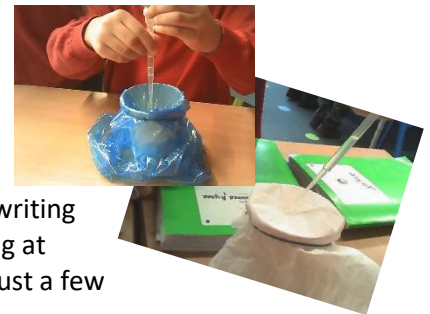
