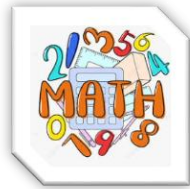


What have Year 2 been up to this week?



This week in English, we have been learning all about Fairytales! We have looked at the story Red Riding Hood. We used some super adjectives to describe the sneaky, bad wolf and used our sense to describe the setting. We discussed how stories are passed down over time and how this means sometimes the same story has slightly different endings. We then looked at another way to tell stories, using Makaton.

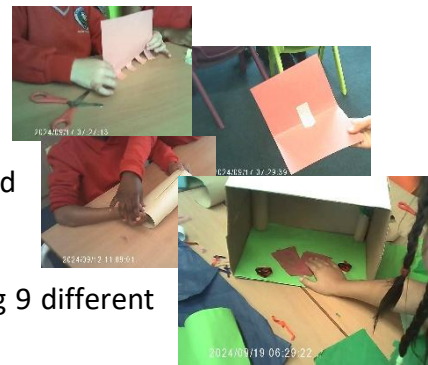
