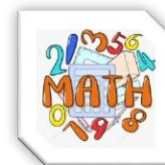


What have Year 2 been up to this week?



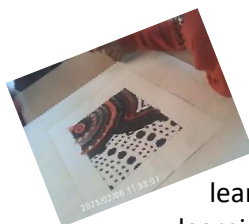
This week in English, the children have been working on their 'meeting tale' stories. They have been practising writing, editing, and refining their work, focusing on clear sentences, descriptive language, and interesting characters. This unit has encouraged creativity while also developing their writing skills and understanding of story structure.

This week in Maths, the children have begun exploring fractions. They have been learning to recognise and understand one half ($\frac{1}{2}$) and one quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$). Through a variety of practical activities, including sharing objects and using visual representations, the children are developing a clear understanding of how fractions represent parts of a whole.



In Topic...

This week, the children have been learning about Indigenous art, exploring its patterns, symbols, and use of colour. They have looked at examples of traditional artwork and have been inspired to create their own pieces, applying the techniques and ideas they have learned to produce imaginative and meaningful art. In History, the children have been learning about the Mary Rose. They explored artefacts from the ship and learned about when it was discovered. In RE, the children learned about the role of church leaders. They explored what church leaders do to help people, including leading services, teaching about God, and caring for the church community.



This week in PSHE, we learnt that celebrating our achievements helps build confidence and shows appreciation for our own efforts and the efforts of others.
