

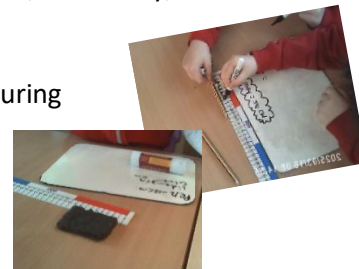


### What have Year 2 been up to this week?



This week in English, the children focused on sequencing instructions. They explored the correct order for making a winding system and learned how to write clear instructions. As part of this, they identified sequencing words such as first, next, then, and finally, and practised using imperative verbs to make their instructions clear.

In Maths, the children have been learning about length. They practiced measuring and comparing different objects using centimetres and metres. The children also learned how to choose the correct unit of measurement and began to understand when it is more appropriate to use centimetres or metres.



### In Topic...

This week, In DT, the children applied their learning by designing and making their own winding systems. They explored how winding mechanisms work and used different materials to create their models. In History, the children have been learning how to ask and answer questions about the past. They explored historical sources and practiced making simple observations. The children also began thinking about the author of a source and the message it gives us, discussing questions such as: What does this tell us about life in the past?



This week in PSHE, we learned about medicine safety.

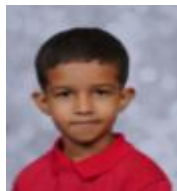
### 2A's Star of the Week
