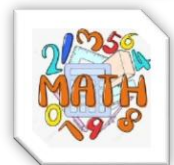
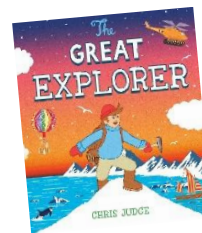
Year 2 Weekly Newsletter – 16th January 2026

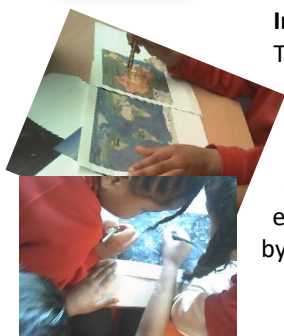

In Geography, they learned about human and physical features, using photographs and satellite images to discover what makes places like China unique. In Music, they listened to and appraised different pieces, exploring elements like beat, rhythm, pitch, and dynamics, and shared how each piece made them feel. In History, they developed their historical skills, by learning about different explorers and putting them in chronological order.
