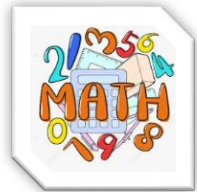




What have Year 3 been up to this week?

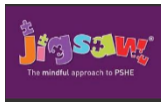


In English this week, we have begun to look at persuasive writing. We read a few examples of persuasive writing, discussing whether it was effective and why. We looked at all the features we need to include within persuasive writing, including title, present tense, conjunctions of cause and rhetorical questions, among others. We looked further in depth at a few and will continue this next week.



In maths this week, we have finished our topic of measure. We looked at addition and subtraction within measure, before moving on to looking at multiplication and division. This week we focused on which processes we need to use to work out the answers. We then completed our end of section review recapping length and volume!

In Science this week, we have started our plant topic. We have explored what a plant needs in order to grow, then using this knowledge, planning a scientific experiment where we test what would happen if one of these things was taken away. Then discussing would this be the same for every plant? We then looked at the different parts of a plant and the life cycle of a plant!



Within PSHE this week we have begun to look at relationships! We worked through a few images showing different people in different jobs, we began to discuss the word 'stereotypes', what this meant and how we can view others! Asking, "Do there have to be specific male or female careers?"
