

What have Year 3 been up to this week?



In English this week, we have been looking at the key skills we need in order to write our story at a year 3 level and to the best of our ability! We looked at adverbs of manner, prepositions of place and time, as well as fronted adverbials! We used these skills over the course of the week, writing about different sections of our story, The Iron Man.



This week in Maths lessons, we have been learning to divide a 2 digit number by a 1 digit number using counters and the place value table. We then moved onto the short division method, also known as the bus stop method! The children really enjoyed using this method to work out division questions really quickly!

In our arithmetic sessions, we have been practising our 4 times tables, recapping number fact families and subtracting within 3 digits.

In Geography this week, we have been learning about how food choices impact the environment. We also learnt about different types of biomes and how different foods need certain conditions to grow. We understood how food with more food miles is less sustainable and uses more energy and how food with fewer miles requires less energy and is more sustainable!



In PSHE this week, we have been understanding how words can be hurtful. We also learnt about empathy and solving problems together.
