What have Year 4 been up to this week?

This week in writing, we have been writing our narratives based on the villains that we have created over the last few weeks. We wrote our stories over the course of the week, focussing on a different part each day.




In reading, we have continued exploring 'Demon Dentist' by David Walliams, thinking about vocabulary within the different chapters, and exploring the skill of retrieval. We have skimmed and scanned the text for clues and specific information.



This week in maths, we have continued to look at decimals. We have rounded decimals to the nearest whole number, focussing on the tenths column. We have also compared decimals using greater than, less than and equal to. We have put a range of decimal numbers into ascending and descending order.

During our topic lessons, we have tried a range of vegetable soups and analysed their taste, texture and appearance, before writing a design criteria about what our own soups needed to have and what could go wrong with the making process. In Science, we explored the digestive system and performed an experiment to demonstrate how food travels through the oesophagus.



In P.E this week, we have practised and refined our forehand and backhand shots, working on the accuracy of our delivery.
