What have Year 4 been up to this week?

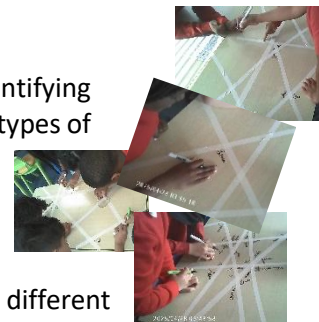
In **writing**, we have begun our unit on persuasive letters. So far, we have analysed the features of a persuasive letter and have seen what a good one looks like. We have also begun to research our arguments for our own persuasive letters.



In **reading**, we have continued *The Butterfly Lion* by award-winning author Michael Morpurgo. Having initially focused on word pronunciation and fluency, we are now developing our language skills to discover why the author made his language choices for the text.



In **mathematics**, we have begun our angles unit. We have been identifying acute, obtuse and right angles. We have also learnt to identify different types of triangles by learning which features they have.
