



### What have Year 6 been up to this week?

This week in English, we have begun exploring our new text: Fantastic Beasts and Where to Find Them. Children have begun to think about their own creature and the qualities they possess. Year 6 have consolidated their knowledge of compound and complex sentences as well as relative clauses. Pupils have learnt about a range of vocabulary that can be used in our non-chronological reports to make us sound like experts! Year 6 have then worked together to create a whole class non-chronological report based on the hydra.



This week in maths, we have learn about the place value of numbers to 10 million and used this knowledge to compare and order numbers up to this value before placing them accurately on a number line.

refraction and how shadows are formed. We have also begun our new unit of electricity and worked as a group to showcase our knowledge.
