




Year 6 Weekly Newsletter – 7th November 2025

What have Year 6 been up to this week?

This week in English, we have explored setting descriptions based on the new novel we are reading in class, 'Skellig'. We have focused the description on contrasting settings (old and rundown to elegant and modern). The writing techniques we have focused on include noun phrases, powerful verbs, complex sentences, relative clauses and similes.



This week in maths, we have learnt how to multiply two fractions and divide fractions by a whole number. We then moved on to finding fractions of an amount.

In Topic...

We began our brand new science unit of animals including humans. The focus for this week's lessons was the circulatory system. The children have understood the function of the heart (including how it works with our lungs), the important role it plays in regulating our body and the different parts of the heart. The children also carried out an investigation to understand the impact exercise has on our heart rate and analysed the results. In PE, we learnt the techniques for running effectively.



In PSHE, we had our first lesson on our new unit: celebrating difference. We explored how we are different from others, and why this is a great thing, and how to empathise with others who are different.



We also had an exciting assembly today delivered by Veolia who spoke to the children about the importance of recycling and what could and could not be recycled.
