




Year 6 Weekly Newsletter – 12th December 2025

What have Year 6 been up to this week?

This week in English, we have been given the task to design a new sleigh for Santa! We began the week by exploring the features of a persuasive text as well as generating ideas to improve Santa's sleigh. We then learnt how to expand main clauses using colon, semi-colons and dashes. To end the week, we persuasively suggested solutions for Santa's sleigh.



This week in maths, we completed the last of our practice SATs papers. We are really proud of the children's determination. We then looked at converting lengths within word problems as well as converting measures of volume.

During our art lessons, we looked at the artist, Jenna Douglass, who produces art through mixed media. We discussed the strengths, weaknesses and materials used across a range of mixed media art pieces. We then practised techniques of applying materials to create a desired outcome as well as the use of lettering. To end the week, we planned our own mixed media art piece based on the heart.

In P.E, we learnt how to show control in take-off and landing when jumping (triple jump).



In PSHE, we explained ways in which difference can be a source of conflict and a cause for celebration. We also looked at strategies for managing our feelings.
