

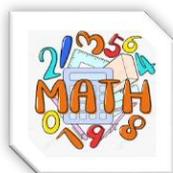

This week in English, we completed a Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar SATS paper and Reading paper. For the rest of the week, we continued to focus on the techniques used in the Jabberwocky poem by Lewis Carroll. This was followed by planning and creating our own poem inspired by this.



This week in maths, our main focus was on time. We converted units of time, converted between both analogue and digital time, calculated intervals of time and then moved on to calculating units of length.

During our science lessons, we focused on the evolution that animals have made by adapting to their current environment. Additionally, we investigated how offspring inherit characteristics from their parents.



In P.E, we learnt how to do a standing long jump.
