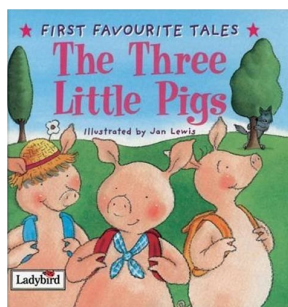


EYFS- Topic (w/c 1.06.20)

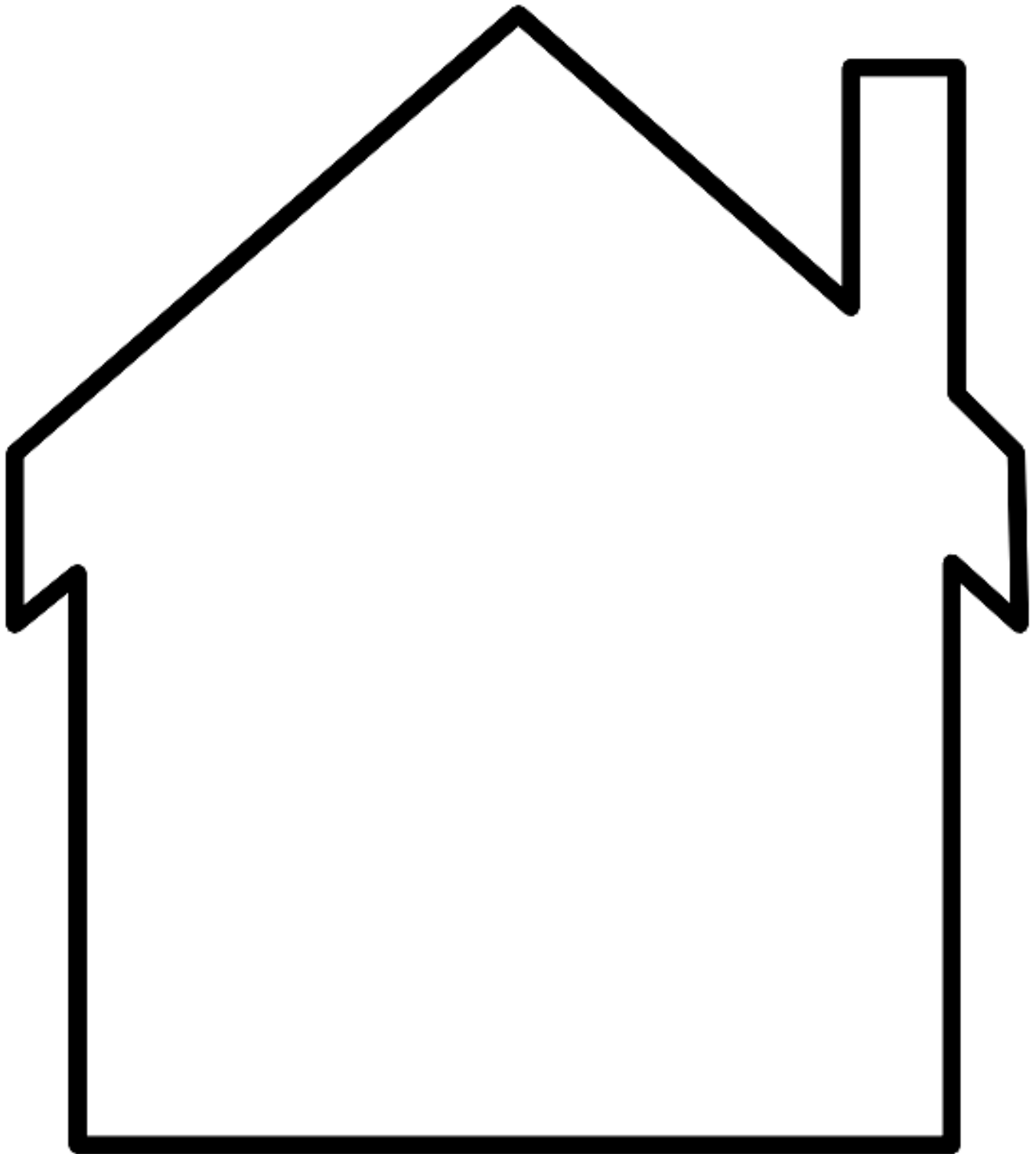
