

## EYFS- Sharing quantities (Lesson 1)

This week, the children will be sharing quantities equally.

This will cover the Mathematics Early Learning Goal-

*Children count reliably with numbers from one to 20, place them in order and say which number is one more or one less than a given number. Using quantities and objects, they add and subtract two single-digit numbers and count on or back to find the answer. They solve problems, including doubling, halving and sharing.*


### Notes:

You can explore sharing practically with toys, cubes, counters etc. Children learn best through play experiences and practical demonstrations.

Keep talking to your child as the language you use will reinforce the learning.

### Activity: Teddy bear picnic

Provide 2 teddy bears/ toys, 2 plates and small even quantities of loose parts/objects to represent different food items. Ask your child to share out the loose parts fairly so that each teddy gets the same. What will happen if another teddy joins the picnic?



### Extension

Provide opportunities for your child to share quantities into groups fairly. This could be sharing out the cards or dominoes at the start of a game, sharing out Lego bricks or toy animals during play.
