Rainbow sponge painting (Page 3)


Spring tree painting in the style of Jackson Pollock (Page 3)

## EYFS Topic Activity 1- Splatter paint hair!

Can you draw a self portrait and then give yourself a new hairstyle?  
If you don't have paint at home, you could create your crazy hair using felt tip pens or colouring pencils.



### Extension:

Perhaps you could give the whole family a brand new hairstyle in a family portrait?



## EYFS Topic Activity 2- Rainbow sponge painting

Jackson Pollock liked to use lots of different colours in his artwork, just like a colourful rainbow!

Can you use a kitchen sponge to create a beautiful rainbow? You could even put it up in your window for others to see!



## EYFS Topic Activity 3- Splatter tree painting



Can you create a painting of a tree during spring using the splatter paint technique? You can splatter your paint by flicking a paintbrush, straw or even a twig! Alternatively, you could create leaves or blossoms using felt tip pens.

## EYFS Topic Activity 4- Tie-dye art

Using baby wipes and felt tips, can you create an abstract piece of artwork?

You will need:

- Baby wipes
- Rubber bands or hair bands
- Felt tip pens / washable markers



1. Pinch the middle of the baby wipe and hold in your hand.



2. Twist.



3. Carefully attach a few rubber bands and use a marker to colour the sections of the baby wipe.



4. Remove the rubber bands, gently unfold the baby wipe and lay on top of two pieces of paper towel until it has dried.
