Specific focus: Police

Subject: Music

Activity Outcome: Create a rap dedicated to the police

Subject: ICT

Activity Outcome: Create a presentation that illustrates who the police are and what they are all about.

- Equipment they might use
- Different departments within the police
- Any other interesting facts you want to include

Subject: Art

Activity Outcome: Design a new badge for the police

Explain: You are going to design a new badge for the police that they can wear on their uniform. Follow the steps below to create your badge. You can choose to use paper or card for your badge.

Step 1: Choose a shape for your badge and draw it out e.g. circle, rectangle, diamond etc

Step 2: Cut out your shape carefully with scissors

Step 3: Choose a background colour for your badge and colour (or paint) it in

Step 4: Add in a motto at the bottom of the badge e.g Aspire, Believe, Succeed (this is our school motto). A motto is a short phrase that describes the belief or idea of an organisation.

Step 5: Add any pictures/patterns that you wish to include. Make it as colourful and as detailed as possible.

Subject: HMHB

Activity Outcome: Create your own set of rules

Explain: You are going to imagine you are a police officer. You are going to create a set of rules that everybody must follow. Be as creative as you like but remember to be fair. Display your rules on an A4 piece of paper and decorate them with pictures and colours. Think about crimes that should not be committed as a basis for your rules e.g. do not steal. You may want to base your rules around some of the ten commandments which can be found on the website listed below.
