Reporting COVID-19 to school

Having a positive case of COVID-19 in your household can be worrying and upsetting. E-Safety on Google Chromebooks

I'd like to take this opportunity to remind you that the Google Chromebooks are for schoolwork, learning, research and education purposes only. As part of our safeguarding software, everything that is done on the Google Chromebooks is tracked. This is to keep children safe. Sites such as YouTube can be viewed but again, only for learning, research and education. Children should not be using the Chromebooks for anything non-school related.

Google Classrooms have a messaging board where children can respond to their class teachers and peers. This board should only be used in between 8am and 4pm. Thank you.

February half-term Free School Meals (FSM) vouchers

All families who are entitled to benefits-related FSM will have received their eCodes earlier this week. These eCodes cover the February half term holiday. Remember parents, the February half term codes are NOT the usual supplier, Edenred, so redeeming them will be different. After the half term break, families entitled to benefits-related FSM will receive codes from Edenred again. These codes will continue to provide funds for essential food for the children. More information to follow about this after the half term holiday.

Food parcels for working families only of EYFS/Y1/Y2

After half term, we are pleased to continue to offer food parcels for our working families of children in EYFS or KS1, who are all entitled to universal free school meals regardless of household income. This offer is different to the national voucher scheme and it is an agreement that we have with our catering service, who have kindly agreed to help out here, which is great.

If you would like to order a food parcel, then you must meet three requirements:

- 1. You <u>must not</u> be receiving the government's Edenred food vouchers for any of your children.
- 2. Your child <u>must</u> be in Reception (EYFS), Year One or Year Two (Key Stage One).
- 3. Your child must <u>not</u> currently be coming to school.

The form will close early on Monday 22nd February 2021 so please do get your order in before then. If you order a food parcel for after half term, you will need to collect this parcel from school on Friday 26th February 2021.
