#### Dear Parents/Carers,

As the country starts to re-open and slowly gets back to a level of 'new normal,' I hope that this newsletter finds your family safe and well. Yesterday, the Government wrote to schools to share the plans for wider re-opening in September. I will write to you next week with the details of this plan but to give you the main point now: the Government expects all children in all year groups to return in September, and attendance is compulsory. #### **School Summer Holiday and September Reminders**

Last week, I wrote to you to say that the last day for children will be on <u>Thursday 16th July 2020</u> at 2pm. We will re-open for all pupils on Monday 7th September. So that we are fully prepared and have up-to-date training, Tuesday 1st, Wednesday 2nd, Thursday 3rd and Friday 4th September will all be Teacher days.

### **Collecting Pupils' Books and Belongings**

A reminder that from next week, you are welcome to come onto school site, at the dates and times below, with your child. (If your child is already at school, they will be bringing their books and belongings home with them). Staff will be under the canopy at the back of the school hall. The children will have the opportunity to say 'hi' to their class teacher from this year as well as collect all of their books and belongings. Note that if books and belongings are not collected, we will be disposing of them and <u>not</u> keeping them over the six weeks holidays.
