SATS 2023 for Year 6

	2 (spelling)
Wednesday 10 May	English reading paper
Thursday 11 May	Mathematics papers 1 (arithmetic) and 2 (reasoning)
Friday 12 May	Mathematics paper 3 (reasoning)
