


Value of the Month – Kindness

Featherstone Primary School is a Values-based school. We received the Values-based Education (VbE) Quality Mark Award in June 2021 to acknowledge our great work that we do with our Values.

The Value of the month for September is Kindness.

By the end of Year 6, we want: "Children are independently kind without being asked; kindness is natural and automatic to Year Six. For example: basic manners are a given, children clean up mess even when it's not theirs and rewards are not necessary. Overall, Year Six are considerate and pleasant to be around." In each year group, children build up to this overall aim. A very important Value to start the year so please talk to your child about the Value of Kindness.





Place2Be

We are proud to continue working with Place2Be, our brilliant mental health and emotional wellbeing charity, who operate on-site five days a week. Place2Be offer two main services for children: (i) self-referral drop-in services for children, who can go and chat to Miss Hayley Lake (our Mental Health Leader) about anything that's on their mind; (ii) clinical counselling for those children who are identified as maybe benefitting from it.
