Welcome back to school. Last half term was an extremely busy time, and we hope you enjoyed it as much as we did. Here are some of the exciting things we got up to...

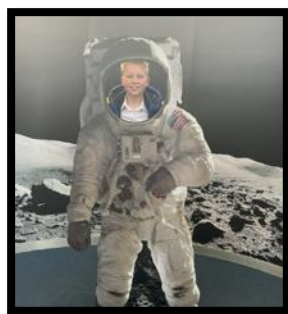
Year 4 Sparks Fire visit

During the last week of half term, we were delighted to welcome the SPARKS unit from Erdington Fire Station for their annual visit. The children took part in an engaging session where they learnt important fire safety skills, including how to stay safe and what to do in the event of a fire at home, such as planning escape routes and calling for help. They also explored key road safety messages to help them stay safe when travelling. The session helped to build confidence and awareness of how to keep themselves and others safe.



Year 5 trip to the Space Centre

Year 5 pupils had an exciting visit to the National Space Centre in Leicester, where they explored interactive exhibits and learnt about space travel. They discovered how rockets are launched and the important role astronauts play on missions. The children were fascinated by the planetarium show, which brought the solar system to life.
