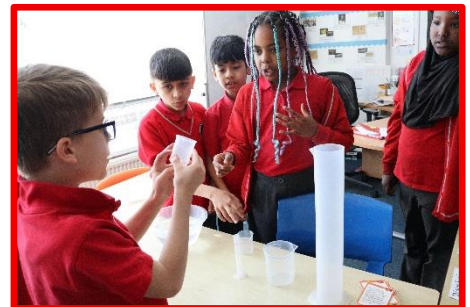


Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to school for the Summer term! This is always a busy time of year, and we look forward to sharing with you all the exciting things happening around school.

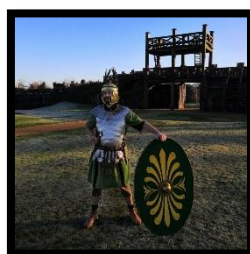
Severn Trent School visit

Our visitor spoke about the importance of saving water. Then following this, we looked at how we can prevent misuse of the sewer system. In Year 4, they investigated wasteful water. They measured how much water fictional characters wasted. This gave us chance to practice our measuring skills for maths! The visitor was so impressed with our school and the behaviour of our children that he sent a lovely email complementing us.
