**This Month's value is 'TRUST'** - Please can you reinforce this value at home so that we have your support.

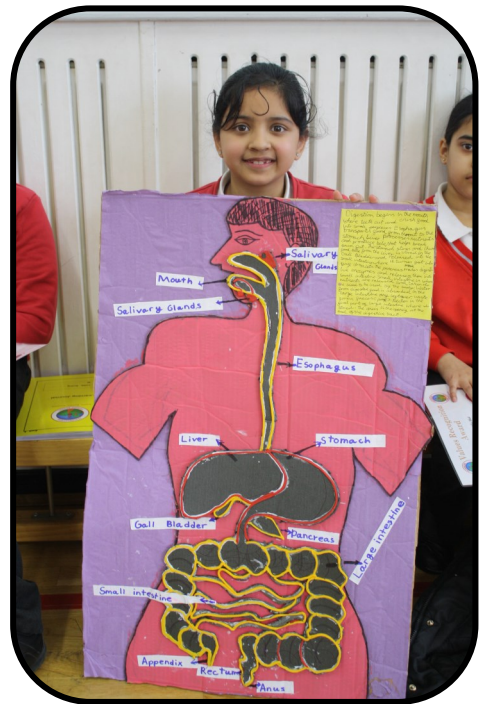
Well done to Year 4 children for their homework topic on the human organ system. The children's work is totally brilliant and some of the ideas are really creative. Thank you parents for getting involved!

### Bad Weather:

In the event of bad weather you will be notified as soon as possible by text message if we have to close. It is important therefore, that the contact numbers for each child is kept up to date.

We will endeavour to keep Featherstone Primary open, but we must consider the risk that the poor weather poses to both staff and pupils of the school.

There are a number of factors that will influence any decision taken to close the school and these may include:

1. Can children and staff get to school safely? This may be affected by public transport.
2. Can children and staff get home safely? If severe weather is expected and may prevent staff and children getting home safely, the school may decide to close.
3. Can enough staff get into school in order to ensure safe staff to pupil ratios?

Please make sure your child comes into school prepared for cold weather (jumper/coat/hat/gloves/scarf) and that all items of clothes are clearly labelled with your child's name. If your child wears snow boots/wellies to school they **must** bring their school shoes to change into.
